

ADAM KUSZAK, PH.D., HEALTH SCIENTIST

Adam Kuszak, Ph.D., joined ODS in August 2014 as an American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS) Science & Technology Policy Fellow. Dr. Kuszak is working with Dr. Joseph Betz to support implementation and oversight of the Dietary Supplements Analytical Materials/Reference Materials (AMRM) Program. In addition, he is contributing to the Office's ongoing development and dissemination of dietary supplement fact sheets for both consumers and health professionals.

Dr. Kuszak received his B.S. in pharmacology and toxicology at the University of Wisconsin – Madison, and his Ph.D. in pharmacology from the University of Michigan in 2009. Prior to joining ODS, Dr. Kuszak completed postdoctoral training in structural biology at the Laboratory of Molecular Biology in the National Institute of Diabetes and Digestive and Kidney Diseases (NIDDK) at the NIH. He also served at the National Institute of Mental Health (NIMH) in the Office of Research Training and Career Development, providing portfolio and program analysis to inform NIH granting policy.
